## **Workshop description**

Using the Pillow pattern "Checkerboard" participants will learn the basic skills for hand quilting with an emphasis on Big Stitch.

Participants will learn how to prepare a quilt for hand quilting. Workshop suitable for all quilters.

### Advance preparation:

Construct Pillow top ready to quilt. Fabric requirements and instruction are listed in the pattern. Pattern is included in the workshop. Be prepared to create quilt sandwich and quilt by hand.

**Supplies**: Checkerboard pattern.

Fabric requirements included with pattern.

Quilt Batting: 22" x 22"
Quilt Top backing: 22" x 22"
Spool of regular sewing thread

Hand sewing needle - long shaft preferred

Old spoon Painters tape Quilter's pins

Quilter's Hoop 14" preferred but not essential

#### Hand quilting tools

Chenille needles size 22 or 24
Threader (as illustrated)
Thimble
Rubber thimble (finger cot)
Perle cotton size 12
Scissors






